They think, "I'm not as good as some people
(I'm no Mother Teresa) but at least I've never murdered anyone! God knows I'm a pretty good person and because of this he will accept me into heaven."

## DID YOU KNOW?

The Bible teaches that getting to God by trying to be a good person is impossible (ROMANs 3). It's like trying to jump from one end of the Grand Canyon to the other. Some of us could jump further than others, but none of us would make it.

## WHAT'S THE STANDARD?

The reason we think we're good enough to get to God is because we compare ourselves to other people. But when we compare ourselves to God and his standard, the Ten Commandments, we all fall short. Here's a quick test to more accurately rate your goodness.

## CHECK THE LAWS YOU'VE BROKEN

$\square 1$ You shall have no other gods before me. Is loving God your first priority? (MARK 12:30)
$\square 2$ You shall not make for yourself an idol.
Are you devoted to anything more than God?
$\square 3$ You shall not take God's name in vain.
$\square 4$ Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
$\square 5$ Honor your father and mother.

- 6 You shall not murder.

Anger towards another is murder. (MATTHEW 5:21-22)
$\square 7$ You shall not commit adultery.
Lust is adultery of the heart. (MATTHEW 5:28)
$\square 8$ You shall not steal.
$\square 9$ You shall not lie.
Including answering these questions!
$\square \mathbf{1 0}$ You shall not covet.

If getting to God depends on being good we've got a serious problem! We'll take a closer look at our problem and God's solution in the next 3 points...

# WE ARE SINFUL \& WE BREAK GOD'S LAW - sin separates us from God \& BRINGS HIS JUDGMENT 

WE ARE SINFUL "No one is good - not even one...
For all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious standard." (ROMANs 3:10,23)

God created people to bring him glory and enjoy life in relationship with him. However, each of us has turned against our Creator by violating his standard and living our own way, which is sin. God is holy. He is completely good and must respond in fierce opposition to our sin.

SIN BRINGS JUDGMENT "Because of your hard and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment

will be revealed." (ROMANs 2:5)



## THE FINAL JUDGMENT

for those who die in their sins is eternal separation from God in hell.
(2 THESSALONIANS 1:8-9)

## JESUS LIVED A SINLESS LIFE _ in love JESUS DIED AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR OUR SINS

## GOD'S LOVE

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." (נонN 3:16)

Even though we turned against our Creator, he loves us and sent his Son, Jesus, to save us from his judgment. On the cross, God the Son endured the holy wrath we deserve so we could be forgiven and accepted by God.

"For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God" (1 PETER 3:18)

# YOU MUST TURN FROM YOUR SINS \& TRUST II JESUS ALONE - only then will you be _FORGIVEN \& ACCEPTED BY GOD 

## TURNING FROM SIN

"Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out" (ACTS 3:19)

## TRUSTING IN JESUS

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them." (JOHN 3:36)

## THINK OF IT LIKE DRIVING A CAR.

The red car represents a self-directed life where you're in the driver's seat. The white car represents a Christ-directed life where you trust Jesus for forgiveness and let him decide which way to go.


## JESUS IS CALLING YOU TO TRUST HIM

You can do that right now. Read over the prayer below to see if it expresses the desire of your heart. If it does, pray to God with faith and He will save you.

Lord Jesus, I admit that l'm not good. I have broken your laws and lived my own way. Thank you for living a perfect life and dying as my substitute. Today I turn from my sins and trust in you for God's forgiveness and acceptance.
